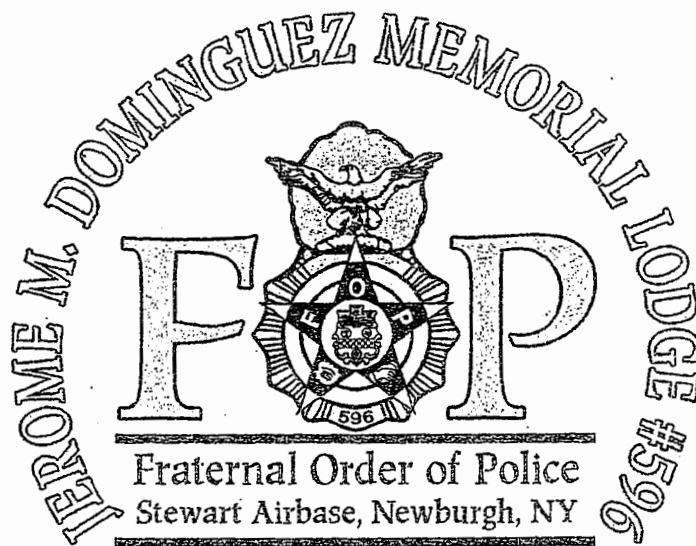

Jerome M. Dominguez served as a police officer in the New York Police Department and as a Staff Sergeant in the New York Air National Guard. Jerome was appointed a NYPD police officer in July 1985. His assignments included NSU 7, the 40 Precinct and Highway Patrol Unit# 1. He was a member of the department's prestigious Honor Legion and a recipient of the New York City Patrolmen's Benevolent Association "Finest Of The Month" award. In April of 1999 he achieved his career goal when he was assigned to the elite Emergency Service Unit. Jerome enlisted as a law enforcement specialist in the 105th Security Forces Squadron, New York Air National Guard in May 1996 (hence our Lodge# 596). He quickly established himself when he garnered the Basic Military Training Honor Graduate ribbon and subsequently won two Distinguished Graduate awards in both Ground Combat School and the USAF Security Police Academy. During the academy he was also decorated with the Air Force Achievement Medal for the rescue of a woman trapped in an auto accident. After intensive statewide competition he was selected as the New York Air National Guard's "1997 Airman Of The Year". He also served as a sniper/observer in the 105th SFS Emergency Service Team.

On September 11th, 2001 in the performance of his duty as an ESU officer, Jerome was an initial responder to the World Trade Center attack. He was evacuating people from the interior of WTC Tower# 2 when it suddenly collapsed. Fraternal Order Of Police Lodge# 596 has been established in his memory and is dedicated to continuing his legacy of professionalism.
